Also 13 dogs were adopted that came to us in 2015.

We had to rehome 11 dogs that could not stay with their owner. 9 of them found already a new home.

4 dogs that came back to us in 2015 found also a new home.

The total amount of adopted dogs in 2016 is 200.

He completely recovered.
